


Bird Netting



An unprotected and open containment pond or frac tank represents a potential threat to migratory waterfowl. Birds view these ponds as an opportunity to rest and feed. If allowed to land, the birds may become poisoned by contacting the chemicals or hydrocarbons present in these ponds. In order to limit bird mortality, bird netting systems are utilized to reduce waterfowl access to these open containment ponds. Nets are suspended over the ponds creating a physical and visual barrier to the birds, drastically decreasing the likelihood of waterfowl even attempting to land.

Contain Enviro Services provides nylon netting designed to protect both local and migratory waterfowl from coming into contact with contaminants. UV resistant and tough enough to be used in any environment, our bird netting will protect your site.

All panels are constructed from $1.5'' \times 1.5''$ square nylon netting in sections large enough to cover the desired area. All panels include a $\frac{1}{4}''$ machine sewn rope border and corners are marked and panels tagged with the size.
